Some of our programs occur outdoors, as such, please remind your students to wear appropriate attire for the season. Below is a list of suggested items to bring to your visit to NYdigs educational programs.

Suggested Items:

- Name tags for students
- Emergency contact information for each student
- Walking shoes
- Lunch
- Water
- Pens or pencils
- Notebooks
- Sunglasses, sunscreen, or hat (if it's hot or sunny)
- Coat, Hat, Gloves, Boots (if it's cold)

Helpful Tips

1. **Prepare your students.** Let them know they are going on a field trip to a park and a greenhouse. Encourage them to ask questions, too.
2. **Provide each student with a name tag.** Addressing students by name is great classroom management for our education staff.
3. **Let us know of any rules or techniques special to your group.** You have the most experience with your class – let us know any techniques that help make the students' learning experience better.
4. **Bring a few hand wipes.** We will have hand washing stations, but when playing in with dirt, students can find it goes everywhere!
