NYdigs offers inquiry based workshops and hands-on activities in the greenhouse & kitchen learning garden at Denny Farrell Riverbank State Park. Each workshop costs \$125 per group. Registration is required.

SCHOOL GROUP WORKSHOPS OFFERED

Birds & Binoculars Put on our binoculars to explore the park. Little scientists investigate the wildlife, plants, and unique park habitat through real live outdoor observations

Sprout Power From Apples to Zucchini, celebrate seeds, how they sprout, and what makes each so unique. Students dissect seeds for an up-close look at their anatomy.

The Seasoned Chef Use freshly harvested herbs to spice up any recipe. Students identify common herbs, use them in a delicious recipe, and plant seeds to take home for the family.

Grow It! Students learn gardening basics: the tools, the seeds, how to take care of them. Everyone takes a plant home. **Spring Only**

Dirt Lab Getting dirty can be good, especially in the garden! Students delve into the complex, organic system of soil to examine the living and non-living elements.
