

#### **Seasonal Greenhouse Education Center Assistant**

The Horticultural Society of New York (The Hort) is hiring Greenhouse Education Center Assistants to support our programs at the Denny Farrell Riverbank State Park. Assistants will work with our Horticulture, Education and Public Space departments. Building upon the farm internship sessions, assistants will increase their knowledge and understanding of seed selection, planting, and pruning in the garden.

- Harvest, wash and process crops
- Assist with pest identification and management

- Support onsite events and programming

- Promote programs through visits to local libraries and community centers
- Create materials to share with Harlem neighbors and on-line community

- Maintain center cleanliness including: emptying garbage, sweeping/mopping floors, and dusting surfaces
- Managing center inventory
